

BELLE AIRE KENNELS BOARDING AGREEMENT

Payment:

Owner agrees that payment is expected in fully before pet(s) are released. Further, owner agrees to pay all costs and charges for special services requested, and all veterinary costs for the pet during the time said pet is in the care of Kennel. It is also understood that a twenty-five dollar (\$25) fee will be charged for any returned checks.

Accuracy of Information:

By signing this Agreement and leaving the pet with Kennel, Owner certifies to the accuracy of all information given on the New Client Information and Pet Information Form.

Reasonable Care:

Kennel shall exercise all due and reasonable care for the pet delivered by Owner to Kennel for boarding, but shall not be liable for loss or damage from disease, injury, escape, fire, or other unavoidable causes. Owner further agrees to be solely responsible for any and all acts or behavior of said pet while it is in the care of Kennel.

Communicable Disease and Parasites:

Owner specifically represents to Kennel that the pet has not been exposed to rabies or distemper within a thirty day period prior to boarding, and that the Rabies, DHLPP/Parvo, and Bordetella Inoculations are current for dogs or FVRCP, FeLV, and Rabies for cats. If not, then said vaccinations will be administered by Kennel's choice of veterinarian at Owners expense. In addition, a twenty-five dollar (\$25.00) service charge will be applied to kennel costs.

Medical Care:

If the pet becomes ill or if the state of the animal's health otherwise requires professional attention, Kennel, in its sole discretion, may engage the services of a veterinarian or administer medicine or give other requisite attention to the animal and the expenses thereof shall be paid by Owner. If your pet requires emergency medical care the kennel will make all attempts to contact the owner.

Abandonment:

If Owner does not pick up pet within five days after the day the pet(s) was due to be picked up, the pet shall be deemed to be abandoned and owner will be reported to the DuPage County Animal Control. Kennel shall first try for a period of five days to find a new owner for the animal. If no new owner is found, animal will become sole property of Belle Aire Kennels and animal placement or not will become the Kennels sole responsibility.

Extended stay:

If a pet is not picked up on the original departure date listed on page one of this agreement the owner is subject to pay the applicable daily rate until day of pick up. Notification of extension is required.

Personal Pet Items:

The Kennel will provide bedding and toys for your pet. The kennel is not liable for compensation of lost or damaged or destroyed items.

After Hours Charge:

Boarding pets are discharge only during regular business hours. We do not discharge pets from boarding outside of business hours unless prior arrangements are made. A \$25.00 charge will be applied to for this service.

Entire Agreement:

This Agreement constitutes the entire agreement between the parties. All terms and conditions of said document shall be binding on the heirs, administrators, personal representatives and assigns of Owner and Kennel.

Controversy or Claims:

Any controversy or claim arising out of or relating to this Agreement, or the breach thereof, or as the result of any claim or controversy involving the alleged negligence by any party to said documents, shall be settled by arbitration in accordance with the rules of the American Arbitration Association, and judgment upon the award rendered by an arbitrator may be entered in any Court having jurisdiction thereof. The arbitrator shall, as part of this award, determine an award to the prevailing party of the costs of such arbitration and reasonable attorney's fees of the prevailing party.
